

# FOR YOU WHO ARE ABOUT TO GO SNOWMOBILING

## REQUIREMENTS

- A valid car driving license is required. Alternatively, you can ride in a sled behind the guide if you prefer not to drive. A passenger sitting behind a driver does not need a drivers license.
- 100% sobriety is mandatory for every driver due to Swedish law.

## WHAT WE PROVIDE

- Insulated clothing, including warm outerwear, shoes, gloves, balaclava, and a helmet.
- A comprehensive driving introduction from your guide.

## CHILDREN

- Children must be tall enough to reach the snowmobile handles and place their feet on the footrests. If they are unable to meet these requirements, they must ride in the sled behind the guide. Small children need to be accompanied by an adult in the sled.
- A sled with its reindeer hide is also a warmer place, perfect for children.

## FOR YOU WHO WISH TO KNOW MORE ABOUT DRIVING & SAFETY

- Follow the guide at all times, who will lead on designated snowmobile trails.

- Observe the hand signals used by the guide for communication during the safari.
- Keep to the right-hand side of the trail, adhering to local traffic regulations.
- The maximum speed limit is 50 km/h.
- Yield to oncoming skiers, dog sleds, and other snowmobiles by coming to a complete stop.
- On icy surfaces such as lakes and creeks, proceed with extra caution due to reduced traction.
- Maintain a safe distance of 10-15 meters from other snowmobiles; this may be reduced to 2-3 meters during stops.
- If separated from the group, stop immediately and stay put; the guide will return to assist you.
- If you have any special medical, or injury problems, please let the guide know before the safari.
